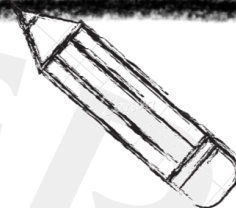

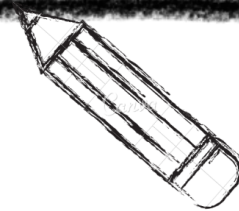

WEEKLY MESSAGE FOR PARENTS



Morning Drop Off Routine:

8:00 am - Breakfast begins - students will be let in door #5

8:10 am - Supervision begins

8:20 am - Bell rings and students line up to be let inside

8:27 am - Students need to be in their seats in the classroom; attendance is taken

Our official start time is 8:27 am per the district. We have been lenient in the past, having a staff member stay at the back door until 8:30. We no longer have the staff availability to stay until 8:30 as staff need to be in their classrooms to be with students. Staff will remain by the back door (#3) until 8:27 to let students in but know that if they are not in their seat by 8:27 they will be marked tardy. All students dropped off in the front must have an adult sign them in. Thank you!

Just a reminder that the circle is a drop off/pick up, please do not exit your vehicle as we need to keep the line moving (at times it can be backed up as far as St Joseph Street). If you need to help your students in and out of the vehicle then we ask that you park in one of the stalls.

When waiting for your student, please pull as far forward as possible so that the line of vehicles behind you may also pull forward. The more vehicles that can be in the circle at one time means more students can load at one time thus keeping the line moving.
