## **Monday, January 22nd - NO SCHOOL:**

## **Parents - we need your help!!**

Please help us in following these guidelines for using the drop off/pick up circle:

### **PLEASE:**

- Pull as far forward as possible, do not stop halfway as this delays the drop off/pick up for those cars behind you.
- Do not exit your vehicle, if you need to help your child in or out of the vehicle, please do not use the circle but park in a stall where you will have the additional time to help your student.
- Do not allow your student to exit the vehicle on the left (driver's) side. This is a safety issue as we often see vehicles pulling around the line.
- Do not allow your students to exit the vehicle until you are in the actual circle where the sidewalk begins. This is also a safety issue as we have seen cars try to pull thru the line and into the parking lot.
- Do not attempt to create a second line of vehicles or try to bypass the line of vehicles to pull in front of those already in the circle. This is also a safety issue as students may run between vehicles.
- There is no parking on the east side of Woodrow Way. Please be aware that you can be ticketed.
- Students are not allowed to play on the playground equipment both before and after school without a parent/guardian present. This is for safety reasons as we do not have staff available to monitor the playground.

## **It's Cough Drop Season!:**

It is district policy (453-4) that students are not allowed to carry non prescription medications; this includes cough drops. All cough drops need to be brought to the office by the parent/guardian and a medication authorization form needs to be filled out and signed by the parent. This is a safety precaution so that cough drops are not overused or shared with other students who may have an allergic reaction. Your help with this is greatly appreciated!
